Minutes of May 11, 2006 Monthly Business Meeting

Location: L.A. County Building, Alhambra Room, 900 South Fremont Avenue, Alhambra

Call to Order: The ICC Los Angeles Basin Chapter monthly business meeting was call to order at approximately 11:50 p.m. by Chapter President Felipe Segovia.

Welcome and roll call of board members in attendance: The welcome to the LA Basin Chapter meeting was extended to the members by Chapter President Felipe Segovia. He took roll call of board members; present were: President Felipe Segovia, City of Torrance, Treasurer Craig Johnson, City of Culver City, Secretary Steve Ikkanda, City of Los Angeles, and Vice President Tim McCormick, City of Santa Monica. Past President Stuart Tom, City of Glendale was not present.

Self-introductions: Self-introduction of approximately 25 members and guests who were in attendance.

Approval of minutes of previous meeting: The minutes of April 13, 2006 was unanimously approved.

Report from Officers and Committees.

Status Report from CALBO, ICC and SFM Core Group.

- **CALBO** – Steve Ikkanda mentioned that California Building Officials Training Institute was providing an education week, June 5 through 8, in San Diego and that the Registration Information will be distributed to the membership.
- **ICC** – Paul Armstrong mentioned that he stopped by ICC and he was asked to distribute “Building Safety” Journal to the membership. Available for purchase are the CD version of the 2006 I-Codes and the AWPA standard.

**Program: Web Conferencing and Online Seminars
Presented by the Chair of the Technology Committee, Neville Pereira**

Neville Pereira gave a short introduction of what was to be presented and showed how, by internet connection, we were able to see the presentation by Matt Troedsen in San Diego and Dave Schnitger of Los Angeles Department of Building and Safety.

They were able to show that **Web Conferencing and Online Seminars** is a tool, any and all members can tune in at will to monthly business meetings, committee discussions, guest speaker presentations and ICC sponsored training seminars.

Inspectors and plan checking staff can get the code training at their desks, in shorter sessions, with nothing other than an internet connection. We can begin building a library of certification seminars that membership can always refer back to on demand. Busy building officials can reserve time to participate in key board discussions without leaving their offices.

It was unfortunate that the demonstration had to be cut short and not all of the demonstration planned for today was presented, because of the technical difficulties due to the internet connection.

Announcements: Felipe Segovia announced that the next LA Basin Chapter will be held on Thursday, June 8, 2006. The program will be about Special (Deputy) Inspection.

In July, the monthly business meeting will be a joint meeting with Orange Empire. It will be held on Thursday, July 20, 2006 in Long Beach. The program will be about the California Building Standards Commission.

In September, prior to the ICC Annual Conference in Orlando Florida, there will be a joint meeting with Southern California Fire Prevention Officers. The program will be about the ICC Code Development Process.
