Minutes of May 10th, 2007 Monthly Business Meeting

Location: Los Angeles County Building, 900 South Fremont Avenue, Alhambra

Call to Order and Host City: The business meeting was call to order by President of ICC-LABC, Tim McCormick, at approximately 12:00 p.m. There was no hoist city for this meeting.

Welcome and roll call of board members in attendance: The roll call of Board Members: Present were: President, Tim McCormick, City of Santa Monica; Treasurer, Steve Ikkanda, City of Los Angeles; and Secretary Roy Itani, County of Los Angeles. Both Past President, Felipe Segovia; and Vice President, Craig Johnson; City of Culver City were absent.

Self-introductions: Due to the anticipated length of the program, the self-introduction of the members was dropped for this business meeting as suggested by Tim McCormick.

Approval of minutes of previous meeting: The minutes of April 12, 2007 was unanimously approved.

Report from Officers and Committees:

On behalf of Hassan Alameddine, chair of the Education committee, Mr. Mazen Dudar from County of Los Angeles announced the upcoming ICC training seminar to take place in July and to stay tuned for future seminars to be announced in the coming weeks. In addition, Mr. Dudar reminded all members to participate their staff in those seminars.

Mr. Truong Q. Huynh, city of Long Beach and chair of ICC LA Basin Chapter structural committee, updated the members on the progress of his committee and discussed the first meeting that was held on May 10 and encouraged more participation from the Chapter. A report will follow in the future to include package of recommended structural amendments to the upcoming 2007 California Building code.

Status Report from CALBO and ICC:

Dennis McCreary from ICC updated the members on the latest ICC activities and reminded all of the upcoming final action code hearings in Rochester, New York beginning May 21st, 2007.

Program: **Transition from the 2001 CBC to the 2007 CBC PART II**
Presented by Stuart Tom, Building official of city of Glendale

The presentation picked up where left off from Part I of last April meeting and Mr. Tom continued to highlight in details the major changes of the upcoming 2007 California Building code based on the 2006 IBC model code and state agencies amendments. Commencing with Chapter 7 of the 2006 IBC, Mr. Stuart resumed to outline the fundamentals code changes section by section and equally introducing the amendments of various state agencies to those sections. He continued to explain some the changes that likely to impact the local jurisdictions and how to administer the new code and its application to new and existing buildings and structures. The presentation was concluded at Chapter 10 of the IBC to be continued as Part II during next business meeting scheduled in May 2007. Follow up on a question by Roy Itani, Mr. Tom indicated that the full presentation will be available on a DVD around July of this year and can be purchased through the Basin Chapter.
