### 6.6 **Education Committee**

Mr. Chon Cervantes, Education committee chair, indicated that the training matrix for the upcoming 2010 codes will be ready in August 2010. Training is scheduled for September 28, 29 and 30 in the City of Norwalk and will be free of charge to local jurisdictions. Classes vary in capacity from 50 to 100 attendees. Seminars will be offered on ADA, wood sciences (APA classes), 2010 code updates for Building, Mechanical, Plumbing, Electrical and seminars on the new Green Building Standards Code.

### 6.7 Code Adoption

Mr. Hassan Alameddine, committee chair, indicated that the chapter must get involved and propose changes at the State and at the National level as well. He indicated that this usually requires that we have an early head start and must keep in mind as we get into the 2013 codes.

He also indicated that the key is to start coordinating early with the state agencies, attend state hearings regarding State agencies' proposed amendments in order for us to further pursue things at the national level.

A meeting has been set for July 19, 2010 in the City of Norwalk to discuss the amendment package with the Orange Empire Chapter and the Ventura Chapter.

### 6.8 Green Building Committee

Mr. Ron Takiquchi, committee chair, indicated that the committee is proposing a total of seven amendments. He thanked co-chair Mr. Ousama Younan, committee secretary Mr. Fouad Barakat, and all the committee members on all their hard work and participation the past six months.
