Dear CA Governmental Member Voting Representatives:

I am writing to you on behalf of the ICC Los Angeles Basin Chapter Administration Committee – Code Coordination Effort (“Committee”). The Committee is taking the lead to facilitate and strengthen code coordination efforts among the various participating chapters, organizations and jurisdictions in California (“CA”). It is the Committee’s goal that increasing collaboration among the various participating CA chapters, organizations and jurisdictions regarding code change proposals will help ensure that the voices of all CA Governmental Member Voting Representatives are uniform and consistent. As such, the Committee believes that these efforts will help to enable CA to have a significant impact on the code development process at the national level. The Committee looks forward to working with participating members and interested parties in supporting these efforts and helping to make CA once again become a leader in the code development process.

In furtherance of that goal, the Committee has been working closely with various CA governmental members that represent participating CA chapters, organizations and jurisdictions engaged in the code development process to evaluate and recommend positions on select code change proposals. With that initial effort now complete, the Committee is recommending to all CA Governmental Member Voting Representatives to support the CA consensus recommended positions pertaining to select code change proposals that received a floor motion during the International Code Council (“ICC”) Committee Action Hearings held on April 19-27 of 2015 in Memphis, TN.

On a secured webpage located at the ICC Los Angeles Basin Chapter’s website at www.icclabc.org under the tabs “Committee” and “Code Administration”, there can be found a document titled “ICC 2018 I-Codes Group A Online Assembly Action Vote v1”. This document consolidates and summarizes the recommended positions by the various participating CA chapters, organizations and jurisdictions to ensure ease of comparison and review for other CA governmental members. The Committee hopes that this document will help to serve as a guide for all CA Governmental Member Voting Representatives when evaluating what code change proposal with a floor motion to vote for online.
